Crossroads of America Amateur Radio Ladies Association

Constitution and By-Laws

Article I - Name

The name of this organization shall be **Crossroads of America Amateur Radio Ladies Association**, referred to in this document as **CAARLA**.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of CAARLA shall be to promote and advance the participation of young ladies (of any age) in amateur radio.

Article III - Membership

There shall be two categories of membership, full and associate. Only full members shall have voting privileges.

Any female amateur radio operator shall be eligible for full membership in CAARLA.

Associate membership shall be open to any person, not eligible for full membership, who supports the purposes and goals of the organization.

Membership in the YLRL, an international organization of female amateur radio operators, is encouraged, but is not required for membership in CAARLA.

Article IV - Officers

The elected officers of CAARLA shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and a Treasurer. Any full member in good standing shall be eligible to serve as an elected officer. Elected officers shall serve for a term of one year. Officers should not serve for more two consecutive terms in the same office.

The President, with the consent of the membership, may appoint any full or associate member to serve as Trustee. The Trustee must hold an amateur radio license of General class or higher, and shall serve for an indefinite term with annual confirmation by the membership.

Article V - Dues

The membership may establish whatever dues as may be deemed appropriate.

Article VI - Amendments

This document may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any regular meeting.
