

MESSAGE PICKUP STATIONS (MPS) FOR KEY AMATEUR RADIO VOLUNTEER BACKUP COMMUNICATION STATIONS IN ALACHUA COUNTY

NOTES:

1. To send a “radio-only” message (completely independent of the internet) to a WINLINK station, you do not need to know which Message Pickup Station(s) they have selected --- the system handles that for you. Rather, all you need to do is to send your message using one of the RADIO-ONLY session types [PACTOR Radio-only or WINMOR Radio-only are the only working possibilities for most people] and send it to any Hybrid station. Hybrid WINLINK Stations are marked with an H on the Winlink station map. Of course, if you happen to send it to one of their chosen MPS stations, it will already be at one of them!
2. TO PICK UP your radio-only messages, however, you MUST make a Radio-only session connection to one of your message pickup stations. You cannot pick up radio-only message by connecting to just any of the WINLINK gateway stations --- your mail has been radio-relayed ONLY to your mirrored Message Pickup Stations.
