This is not only for honoring our dearly departed clubmate Lenore, this is also a chance to promote our club. I had nominated Lenore for the CQ Hall of Fame. Lenore already won the Dayton Lifetime Achievement award. Lenore co-founded YLRL. During WWII she was a code instructor for the Navy. In the 50s she was a pioneering phone patcher helping military personnel stationed in the Arctic and Antarctic communicate with the families. In 1961, she was profiled on This is Your Life (which we will show in Torrance). During the Vietnam War Lenore made 10,000s if not 100,000s of phone patches for our brave fighting men and women. After the war, she was key in promoting ham radio. .....On top of all this she was our clubmate. Please come to the session to celebrate Lenore's induction into the CQ Hall of Fame on Sat. afternoon (exact time TBA) Sept. 10, 2011 at the ARRL Southwest Convention at the Torrance Marriott.
