Some Red Cross forms were lost in shelter kit due to flood water.</p> <p>Cafeteria has been providing regular meals because it is on hand and neighborhood generator used to fuel cooking equipment.</p> <p>Behavioral Health issues are elderly who have memory issues and one homeless woman who talks to herself non-stop.</p> <p>Two people from same family either have stomach flu or food poisoning</p> <p>5 people on dialysis; one needing a treatment within 24 hours. Others need within next 3 days.</p> <p>2 people did not bring wheelchairs and 3 need shower chairs to bathe. 3 additional need canes or walkers.</p> <p>1 diabetic needs to refrigerate insulin.</p> <p>Security incident with homeless lady bothering other residents and going through their stuff.</p>
