


# Hurricane Bunnell 2019 SET Rules


- 1. Use of cell phone's other than for emergencies or injects is not aloud.
- 2. Internet will be down for anyone within the Red and Yellow areas on the chart. **See below.**
- 3. Winlink RMS HF stations might be down in Northern Florida Section.
- 4. **SARNET will not be a directed net**. There will be a station on-air acting as the NCS, but it will be run as an open net and no formal traffic can be passed using SARNET. Only pass tactical information using SARNET.

Below is a color representation of how Hurricane Bunnell will affect your area. Please follow the condition listed for that area.


## Hurricane Force Winds

- 1. All utilities have been damaged or destroyed. Electricity, Internet and Water pump for gas and sewage are out.
- 2. Roads are blocked by flooding (Lakes, Rivers and beach's flooding roads) and debris (Tree's, Light poles, Street and business signs)
- 3. Some staged resources are coming but they will need to pass though the Blue and Yellow zones. They will not arrive within the exercise time frame.
- 4. There will be no internet for you during this exercise. All VHF/UHF Winlink gateways using internet will also be down unless it is connected to a HF gateway station.




# Strong Tropical Force Winds

- 1. Some utilities have been damaged or destroyed in random locations. Electricity, Internet and Water pump for gas and sewage. All power will be restored by 1100 EDT.
- 2. Some Roads are blocked by flooding (Lakes, Rivers and beach's flooding roads) and debris (Tree's, Light poles, Street and business signs) Mostly roads with lots of tree's and lowlands.
- 3. Some staged resources are coming. They will not arrive until after 12 pm ET.
- 4. Internet in your county will be out until 0930 EDT. All VHF/UHF Winlink gateways using internet will also be down unless it is connected to a HF gateway station. Once internet is restored these stations can return.




# Tropical Force Winds

- 3. You have random roads closed due to tree's and debris closing the roads.




# Hurricane Bunnell Past 72 Hours








