Handling Back and Forth:

- “Over” A reply is expected, “go ahead.”
- “Out” No reply is expected. Do not respond (like “hanging up” the phone).
- “Roger” Received and Understood (NOT “Yes”)
- “Affirmative” Yes
- “Negative” No
- “Clear” Same as “Out.” No reply is expected.
- “Say Again” Repeat

Getting A Message Across

- I SPELL
- INITIAL (or INITIALS, as the case may be)
- FIGURES (zip codes, telephone numbers, zip codes, or combinations of numbers)
- MIXED GROUP (figures and letters)
- BREAK (what you say between sections; except Shannon has concluded we should use PAUSE on local vhf repeaters)
- AMATEUR CALL SIGN
