TIPS & POINTERS

- **DO NOT POST** items – all adverts should list “local pick up” & “sold as is”,
- No PayPal, PayID or Bank Deposits – **CASH ONLY**. There have been instances where the funds have been reversed and the items stolen. You will be able to sell all items locally, or in **<YOUR TOWN/ CITY>** with out a problem.
- Try and involve the person or club listed on each page, they can demonstrate the item to the buyer as working.
- Be careful if a club wants to do a “yard sale” or “car boot sale” or “HAMfest”. Vultures, vultures everywhere. I've seen \$1000 items go for as little as \$100 don't do it; take your time, be patient.
- Make sure prices are listed accurately and know how much you are prepared to move on the asking price. Its better to ask a little high and negotiate.
- Block the trolls

IDENTIFICATION

I have tried to identify all of the equipment that is of value. Complete with my cost price, place of purchase, condition when bought and serial numbers where available. A photo is included where possible so you know what it looks like.

If its on the desk where I usually sit or on the tower it will be in working condition.

There are a number of Facebook pages that I am a member of where you can sell all this gear. Log into my profile and look under groups.
