Here are some basic steps for setting up your Field Day station for maximum fun.

1. Begin a plan with others or within your club.
2. Coordinate your site access.
3. Speak with served agencies or local officials to encourage public interest.
4. Publicize your plans, listing your event information via the ARRL web site Locator page and elsewhere.
5. Prepare for site set up and review safety information.
6. Arrive at site and begin set up.
7. Inspect power source, antennas and equipment for proper connections and grounding.
8. Synchronize your clocks.
9. Get your logging tools, pencils and operating plans ready to start.
10. Get on the air and have fun.
